FORMALDEHYDE

Kwalu's seating products are compliant with the low emissions criteria of the ANSI/BIFMA Furniture Emissions Standard (M71/X71-2011 R2021) and ANSI/BIFMA e.3-2019 (Credits 7.6.1, 7.6.2, 7.6.3) for seating parameters. Our seating also conforms to the CDPH/EHLB Standard Method (CA 01350) v1.2-2017 for seating. This compliance has earned our products the SCS Global Services' Indoor Advantage™ Gold label – which is the highest level of indoor air quality performance for seating. PERFLUORINATED COMPOUNDS (PFCs)

Kwalu's seating is PFC free – unless specified with a fabric or with a stain repellent that contains PFCs. Customers are responsible for COM fabric treatments and chemical content.

POLYVINYL CHLORIDE (PVC)

Kwalu seating with Classic finishes can be specified to include PVC content below the <1% by weight requirement – by selecting **Option HH**. Note: Seating products will not comply if specified with Fusion material, Solid Surface material, and/or non-compliant upholstery. Customers are responsible for COM fabric treatments and chemical content.

ANTIMICROBIALS

Kwalu's Option HH Seating Frames are antimicrobial-free. Customers are responsible for COM fabric treatments and chemical content.

FLAME RETARDANTS

Kwalu seating complies with the guidelines – unless ordered with either the CAL 133 option or certain upholstery choices. Customers are responsible for COM fabric treatments and chemical content.
